He run a very, very good place. I found him to be very honest. I found him to be a very skillful trader and people got along with him. And for all they say that they didn't get along he'd two wives at the time. One was the oldest one and one was the one he traveled with. But I found him to be... well he was an exceptional. I mean to say he is like what we have. You know these business tycoons well how'd they get there. Well Angulalik was a business tycoon and an Eskimo. He was a true trader.
